HOW YOUR DONATION IS USED

Sponsorship donations must only be used for actual and necessary expenses directly related to competition and competition related fees and expenses. These fees and expenses may include team and competitor meet fees and required apparel. Transportation, lodging and meal expenses for coaches while competing at away meets and events.

Contributions may not be used for any individual gymnast's training expenses, nor may they be allocated for any specific gymnast in any way, but must be used to cover the expenses of the team as a whole.

This rule must be adhered to in order to preserve and maintain their USA Gymnastics amateur status as well as to not interfere with their NCAA athletic and scholarship eligibility.
